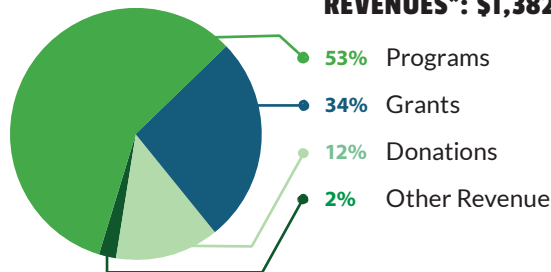

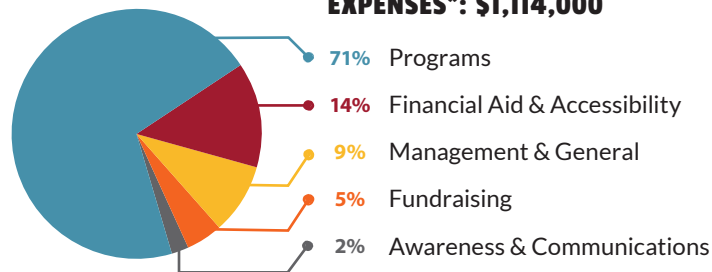

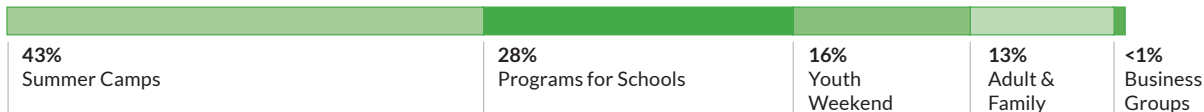
**REVENUES\*: \$1,382,000**

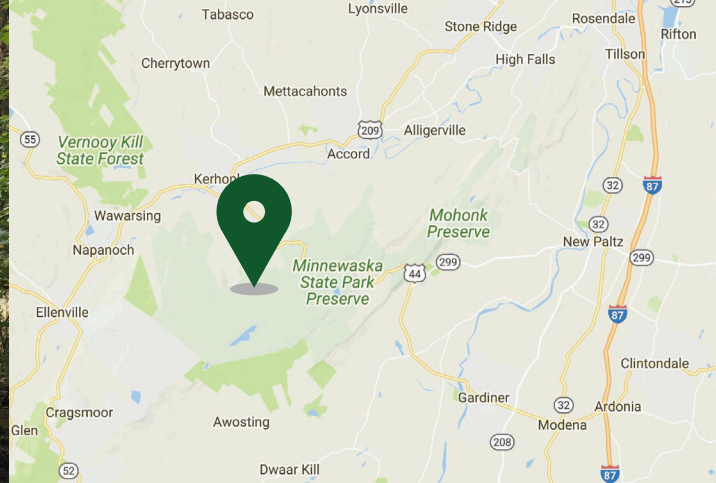
